Online Check-In Process

To complete the online check-in please follow these instructions:

- 1. Log in to your GOTSoccer team page
- 2. Click on the event name located under "Event Registration History"
- 3. Click on the "Documents" tab on the far right
- 4. Load Documents

The following documents must be uploaded into your team's GOTSoccer account no later than **15 days prior tournament start date**. Any changes made after the deadline may disqualify you from Online Check-In unless communicated to the Soccer office.

- Approved/Certified Roster from your State/National Association
- Player Passes
- Individual Players- Medical Waiver (US Club or US Youth)

Please note:

All uploaded files should be in PDF format. Documents uploaded in JPEG format will not be accepted. No photos of documents will be accepted.

Documents should be uploaded as 1 file per category rather than individually scanned and uploaded. Example:

Document 1: Official Approved Roster

Document 2: Player Passes

Document 3: Individual Player Medical Waivers

In addition to the above documents, the team's coach must bring; Team Roster, Each Player's Pass, and Medical Release Forms with them **to each game**.

H) WEATHER-RELATED ALERTS

We avoid cancelling games due to adverse weather if at all possible, and choose venues that have a high resistance to adverse conditions. So do not assume games are being cancelled without firm c onfirmation. Also, do NOT assume that the weather conditions outside your window are the same at the gamesite fields; experience has shown that weather patterns in our area can be highly localized.

In the event of lightning, we will cease play immediately. We may also suspend play in the event of a substantial downpour. Games in the second half will likely be declared as completed. Please have your team get to shelter, and have a system for contacting each team member. Twenty minutes after a stoppage, send ONE team representative to HQ, where we will inform all affected teams of the current status of play, and when we expect to resume.
